If a fax is being sent, the device receives the fax. If the machine does not sense a fax signal, it will ring 5 times in a different tone to tell you it may be a regular telephone call. If you are going to use the answering machine, we recommend setting the Receive mode to AUTO. When you get a call, the machine answers after the second ring, and receives the fax automatically. When reception is complete, the machine returns to Ready mode. If you want to change the number of rings before it answers, see Set rings to answer on page 27. In Ready mode, TL appears in the right hand corner of the display.
